This workshop provides a forum for extending ideas about theory and practice for this challenging client group, where group art therapy is the intervention of choice. Theory and case material will provide the basis for reflection and participants will have the opportunity to share experiences from their own practice. Attention will be given to the aims of groups; boundary-keeping; losses in the group; interpretation; handling the counter-transference and the implications of co-therapy. The workshop will be of particular value for Art Therapists already running groups. It will also be of interest to Art Therapists with experience in individual work who would like to extend their practice to include groups for children or adolescents.

***Diana Velada** is a State Registered art therapist and her masters, obtained through the Tavistock Clinic, was in Psychoanalytic Observational Studies. She is a BAAT recognised supervisor and private practitioner. She has experience of working in CAMHS, primary and secondary schools, children's residential care homes, and private practice. With a degree of regularity, her engagements with children and young people have been through group work.*

Peppy Wilson first trained at Central School of Art & design from 1972 to 1975, studying painting and stained glass. Following this, she worked freelance making stained glass windows and teaching in Adult Education. She qualified as an Art Therapist in 1994 at Hertfordshire.
