ART THERAPY FOUNDATION COURSE  
WEDNESDAYS

17<sup>th</sup> September to 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2008 – 1.30pm TO 5.45pm

This course is intended for people who may consider Art Therapy as a career, and want to train as an Art Therapist. It is also useful for healthcare workers who want to gain a better understanding of Art within a care context. This course will offer an opportunity to gain a deeper understanding of Art Therapy with different client groups, as all speakers are experienced Art Therapists presenting clinical work from their own art therapy practice. It also has an experiential element, as Art Therapy experiential workshops are also included. No previous formal experience of art making is required, but it is important to be prepared to take part in artwork.

It will run on Wednesday afternoons from 1.30pm to 5.45 pm (1.30pm to 3.30pm for the first and last session). The course will commence on **Wednesday, 17<sup>th</sup> September** and the final date will be **Wednesday, 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2008**. The afternoon will consist of lectures and experiential Art Therapy workshops.

**Fee: £400** (payment in 2 instalments may be arranged – one with current date and one dated 8<sup>th</sup> October 2008). The fee includes a course pack with selected articles.
