



TRAINEE MEMBERSHIP

Trainees must be students currently attending an MA or MSc in Art Therapy course at a validated training establishment in the UK.

Benefits

You will receive the Newsbriefing (BAAT newsletter) twice a year and the frequent news and jobs bulletin. You will be able to access the quarterly International Journal of Art Therapy: Inscape (IJAT) online and receive the two printed issues in a double volume twice a year. You will get access to the members-only section of the BAAT website, where you will find help, advice and resources to help you in your studies, including packs such as 'Note writing and the law', 'Off the Peg Audit Handbook' and the BAAT Research library. You will be able to attend BAAT local group and Special Interest Groups meetings. Trainee members will be eligible for a reduced rate for the short courses and conferences run by BAAT.
